#### ABOUT 70% OF RESPONDENTS BELONG TO COMPANIES IN THE ENERGY SECTOR

About 50% of the professionals surveyed belong to ESCOs, OEMs or Utilities.

Another 30% work in facility management companies. And the rest in sectors such as retail, industry, among others.



# 2

#### FOR 43% OF COMPANIES, ENERGY-RELATED COSTS ARE STILL RISING.

Only 19% said they perceived their energy costs had been reduced.

#### 39% OF ENERGY PROFESSIONALS MANAGE BETWEEN 2-20 BUILDINGS

Only 10% of professionals surveyed said they managed +100 locations.

A low percentage (11%) only manage the energy of a single building

#### 44% OF COMPANIES WILL INCREASE THEIR ENERGY MANAGEMENT BUDGET BY 2019

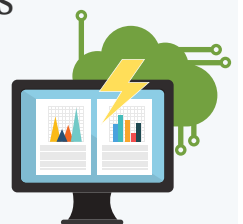
Only 7% of professionals surveyed indicated that their companies have reduced their energy management budget by 2019.
